Through a joint venture, Bejaia Mediterranean Terminal, Portek holds a 20-year concession to jointly operate the Bejaia Mediterranean Terminal with Entreprise Portuaire de Bejaia, the Algerian port authority. Currently the port handles an annual throughput of about 80,000 TEUs in 2006.
